

Recent Canvas Update impacts VeriCite assignment Advanced Settings
February 22, 2017

It has come to our attention that the January 28, 2017 update to our Canvas system had an inadvertent impact on Canvas assignments which use VeriCite.

When all of the VeriCite advanced items are checked, after the first student submits a paper to the assignment, the bottom two options become unchecked. (Exclude self-plagiarism and Store submissions in Institutional Index). (See screen shots below).

Canvas is aware of and is trouble shooting this issue.

Who is Impacted:

Instructors who created a Canvas assignment, checked “Enable VeriCite Submissions” and at least one student has submitted a paper to the assignment.

What To Do Now:

If your VeriCite assignment has at least one student submission:

- Edit the assignment and click on the Advanced VeriCite Settings.
- Check all three boxes.
- Click Update Settings.
- Save the assignment.

If the assignment has no student submissions, no action is required.

In the short term, for new and existing VeriCite assignments, all three advanced settings options will be treated as “checked” whether they are checked or not.

Long Term Fix:

We will let the campus know when this issue is resolved. Then instructors will be able to select which advance options to use or not use.
